6. Click "Group Attendee" then enter code in the empty box directly below. **NUSHA17**
7. Click "Add." A box should then appear with the group's information.
8. Click on "Complete Reservation"
9. Enter # Adults, Children, Rooms, Children's ages (as applicable)
10. Click "Update Guests & Rooms"
11. Select Dates of Stay using calendar (< or > to scroll to month)
12. Click on days of calendar to select dates of Check-in and Check-out as prompted.
13. Click "Update dates of stay"
14. Choose Accommodation type and continue with reservation process until complete.
