**Name:** Communication with teachers to keep students healthy and in class

**Instrument:** Teacher Survey (attached)

**Directions for Administering the Instrument:**

- All teachers will be sent the Communication Survey to complete by June 6, 2014
- All teachers in the district will be required to complete the surveys within one week of receiving it
- The online survey link will be emailed to all teachers in each school in the district
