



























Vulnerable populations are at increased risk of gun violence


- Women experiencing intimate partner violence are up to 5-12X more likely to be killed if there is a gun in the home
- · Gun violence disproportionately affects communities of color
- Gun misuse and suicide is problematic among older adults, especially among people with cognitive impairment
