



### Obtaining your Certificate of Contact Hours

#### To receive contact hours:

1. Fully participate in the learning activity and make note of the code shared at the end of the event.
2. Complete the online evaluation at <https://neusha.org/index.php/partner-program-listing/> by:
  - a. Creating a partner account (**red arrow**) if you do not already have one. To create a partner account, click on Create A Partner Account. Enter your email address and password, your account information, and submit. On the next page, type the code in the Program Evaluation Code box.
  - b. If you already have a partner account, type the Program Evaluation Code in the Program Evaluation Code Box (**blue arrow**), log into your account, complete the Evaluation, and click submit.
