REFUGEE & IMMIGRANT ASSISTANCE CENTER

- · Community-based, non-profit, grassroots human service agency.
- Provides comprehensive services to refugees, asylees, and immigrants refugee resettlement, asylee case management, counseling, outreach and education, and other social services.
- Began its resettlement program in 2001.
- More than 200 refugees from different countries including Bhutan, Iraq, Congo, Syria, Afghanistan, Burma, Somalia, and Ethiopia resettled annually by RIAC in greater Boston and Worcester.
- RIAC's resettlement is done through its affiliation with Ethiopian Community Development Council (ECDC).
- ECDC is one of nine national agencies authorized by the Department of State to resettle refugees in the United States.
- RIAC has offices in Boston, Lynn, and Worcester.





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ASCENTRIA



ASCENTRIA CARE ALLIANCE

- Works in conjunction with the U.S. Department of State and the Massachusetts Office of Refugees and Immigrants.
- Is a non-profit to resettle and establish individuals and families fleeing conflict and oppression in their homeland.
- Began its resettlement program in 1997.
- Offer a continuum of community-based programs for refugees and immigrants including immigration legal assistance, assistance with unaccompanied refugee minors, and comprehensive services for new Americans.
- Ascentria has offices in Worcester and West Springfield Massachusetts, and Concord, New Hampshire.



REFUGEE HEALTH CLINICS

FAMILY HEALTH CENTER

- A clinic dedicated to comprehensive care of newly arrived refugees, asylees and asylum seekers.
- Initial health assessments as required by the Department of Public Health for newly arrived refugees and persons newly granted asylum.
- A committed team including care coordination, medical assistants, scheduler as well as integrated behavioral health.



EDWARD KENNEDY HEALTH

- A provider of the Refugee Health Assessment Program
- One of only several sites in Massachusetts to conduct refugee health assessments
- Employ staff who speak refugee languages including a community health worker and nurse who speak Swahili, two medical assistants and a medical interpreter who speak Nepali, and a community health worker and medical interpreter who speak Arabic


